SOCIALLY-DISTANCED FUNDRAISING IDEAS

ONLINE WITH FRIENDS & FAMILY

- Run an online cooking class. Send the recipe to your friends so they can cook along with you. Charge a demonstration fee to help with your fundraising.
- Organise a Zoom trivia night. Charge an entry fee to participate and encourage additional donations throughout the night.
- Host an online yoga or HIIT class.
 Speak with local providers to see if they would be interested in running a virtual session for your friends. Charge a fee to participate.

CHALLENGE YOURSELF

- Be brave and shave, wax or colour your hair.
- Get sponsored to give up a guilty pleasure like alcohol, chocolate or social media for a month.
- Set a goal to walk, run, ride or swim a certain distance and get sponsored per km.

AT WORK

- Organise a lamington, chocolate or pie drive. Contact your local bakery or a confectionary distributor for a delicious range of options.
- Choose a theme such as the colour yellow to represent the Sunshine Walk, and ask people to dress up for a day.
 Charge a gold coin donation.
- Make a coin trail and see what distance you can cover with donated gold coins.
